

PARK RULES VILLAGE OCÉLANDES

Bungalow

We assume that you will respect others' property. Use the commodities only for their intended purpose. To avoid damage, please do not play football and similar games around the house.

You can not walk through other people's gardens. You should only use the constructed roads and paths.

It is forbidden to set up tents and sleep outside. It is forbidden to have more people overnight than the permitted number.

To water the gardens, the sprinklers will come on during the night several times a week. In the evening, please make sure there is nothing on the grass. The lawns are also mowed once every 14 days. This can cause some inconvenience, we ask for your understanding.

When (temporarily) leaving the house, close the roof windows, fold up the sun shades and parasols and bring in the garden chair cushions. In this area unexpected storms and /or showers can occur .Obviously, the house should also be properly locked.

Safety

Everyone is obliged to report at the reception as soon as possible after arriving and also when finally departing. Parking on the roads is forbidden, cars / motorbikes / trailers must be parked in the designated parking areas. Campervans and caravans are not allowed. On the roads is a maximum speed of 15 km per hour.

It is strictly forbidden to use open fire. Only electric barbecues may be used. The instructions from the park manager to prevent fire should always be followed.

Hygiene

You need to dispose your garbage in sealed plastic bags in the containers along the Route du Tailleur . Make sure that no garbage is left outside overnight.

Alongside the garbage containers there are also glass, paper and plastic containers.

To prevent blockages in the sewer system, please use the toilets only for their main purpose and not for deposit of sanitary towels, tampons etc.

Swimming pool

Before using the pool you are required to shower and to rinse your feet.

Smoking is not allowed at the pool.

To prevent damage to the pumps and to ensure the water quality:

Do not leave anything in the water (the pool is neither a toilet nor a trash can)

(Swimming pool)

Bringing food and drinks to the pool is forbidden. This is due to the strict French law in this area and for hygienic reasons.

The use of air beds and balls is not allowed.

It is forbidden to be at or in the pool outside of the opening hours.

As a parent, you have to be aware that no supervision is present. For unattended stay of children in or around the pool, the house owners / Owners' Association and the Park Manager accept no liability whatsoever.

Children without a swimming certificate are only allowed to swim when accompanied by an adult and when using swimming supports.

Please return chairs and/or parasols to their original location and fold up the parasols.

Tennis court

Admittance to the tennis court is only allowed with proper shoes (no black soles). Before using the tennis court put your name and house number on the appropriate list at the reception.

The maximum playing time is 1 hour per day, during high season it is 45 minutes per day.

Peace and quiet

You must ensure that at no time the peace and quiet of the park is disrupted. You need to limit the scope of the sound of audio equipment, televisions and musical instruments to the boundaries of your bungalow.

Pets

Guests are not allowed to bring pets.

Liability

House owners / Park Homeowners' Association and the Park Manager can not be held responsible for theft, loss, damage or injury to the individual as a result of accidents during the stay at the park. Also they can not be held liable for possible break down of technical equipment or closure of park facilities.

Nuisance

Any nuisance to others in any form is prohibited. If you have complaints about anything, please report them at the reception. The park management will do everything necessary to keep nuisance during gardening and other necessary maintenance to a minimum.

The Park Manager (or his representative) has the jurisdiction to remove any person from the premises who fails to comply with the aforementioned regulations, which include the rules that apply to normal social behavior.
